STEVE'S STRAIGHTS

It's been over a year since I sent any input to the *Flimsy Board*.

Malvern received about two inches of outer band rain from Hurricane Beryl. Otherwise things are quiet here Malvern & Ouachita Valley territory.

You probably saw the picture of the loaded 50' SP double-door boxcar on page 37 of the July issue of the *NMRA Magazine*. I have that same Athearn blue-box model I bought it in early 1972, so it predates the club by a year. The information on the sides shows 1957 as the year the prototype was built. In 1957 Espee steam was in its twilight I mark the prototype construction year on each of my model freight car boxes. That way I can pick freight cars contemporary to the motive power I am running.
